COPPERFIELD INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL FINANCIAL INFORMATION 2024 - 2025

This document provides the financial information for Copperfield's tuition and boarding fees for the 2024/25 academic year, as well as other charges, financial conditions, and payment information relevant for those enrolled or considering admission.

Our school fees consist of three parts: annual & seasonal tuition fees, annual & seasonal boarding and additional charges based on individual circumstances.

The year groups below are listed in line with the UK school year system, with the typical cut off date of 31st August.

Copperfield offers a 15% sibling discount for second and subsequent children who are enrolled. The discount will always be applied to the younger child's fee.

DAY STUDENTS

Annual tuition fee is inclusive of:

- Tuition, Monday to Friday
- Lunch and morning snacks
- Sports, events and cultural activities
- Classroom educational equipment and stationery
- Exam fees
- Mandatory educational field trips and excursions (excluding some curricular trips where fees are charged by third parties)
- Use of school devices

- Ski lessons during the week (normal programme)

Annual tuition fees do not include:

- Uniforms
- Special Educational Support
- Private Music lessons (Piano, Singing)
- Private Academic & Language lessons
- Ski pass and weekend skiing
- Ski equipment &/or rental
- Optional cultural and recreational group trips

BOARDING STUDENTS

Boarding fees are inclusive of:

- Full seven-day room and board during the academic term
- Weekend Outings / Excursions (excluding some where third party costs are incurred)
- Bed linen and towels
- Swiss resident permit and communal taxes
- Supervised studies
- Uniform

Boarding fees do not include:

- All school holidays - including 1/2 term holidays
- Health, medical & travel insurance
- Dentist, orthodontist fees, medication and doctor consultation
- Airport transfer fees & special escort if required
- Pocket money
- Telecommunications: postal expenses, DH

ADDITIONAL PROGRAMMES

The school offers a variety of support programmes to support the students on their individual educational path, such as tuition in specific subjects (most often languages), learning support, executive coaching and college counselling. The fees for the individual support programmes will be agreed with parents prior to any programme being put in place. The following are the main programmes offered for which fees will be charged.

Learning Support

- 1 or 2 lessons per week, charged termly

Private Music Lesson (one-to-one)

- 45 mins (Piano, Singing, Drums etc)

Private Academic Lesson (including language options)

- 45 min lessons

Wellbeing Sessions

- 45 Mins (Extra Session outside allocated monthly slot)

PAYMENT TERMS & CONDITIONS

ANNUAL TUITION FEES

- Payment of the tuition fees for the upcoming academic year will be split in two invoices:
 - 50% will be invoiced no later than **15 June** and is due **30 July**.
 - 50% will be billed no later than **15 October** and is due **15 December**.
- A student's place may be forfeit if tuition fees are not received by the required date.
- Tuition fees are reviewed annual, and are subject to increase from time to time.

LATE PAYMENT

- In case of late payment of tuition fees or miscellaneous items, Copperfield reserves the right to charge 1% per month interest. When tuition fees are unpaid, the student may not be allowed to return to the school until the outstanding balance has been paid.

ENROLMENT OF A NEW STUDENT

- After receiving an enrolment offer, a student's place is only reserved upon payment of the enrolment deposit and signing the enrolment contract. The enrolment deposit is returned after a student leaves the school, provided the student account has been fully settled.
- In the event that a new student's enrolment is cancelled in writing before 30 June, paid tuition fees will be reimbursed in full; the deposit and registration fee will not be reimbursed. After 15 June, tuition fees for the autumn term are due even in the event of cancellation.
- In case of late enrolment, tuition fees for the remaining part of the academic term are due within 15 days upon receipt of the invoice and must be paid before joining. In case of withdrawal or cancellation, the tuition fees are not refundable.

TERM DATES

- Term dates for 2024/25 academic year are as follows:
 - Autumn: 2 Sept to 20 December
 - Winter: 7 January to 11 April
 - Summer: 29 April to 27 June.
